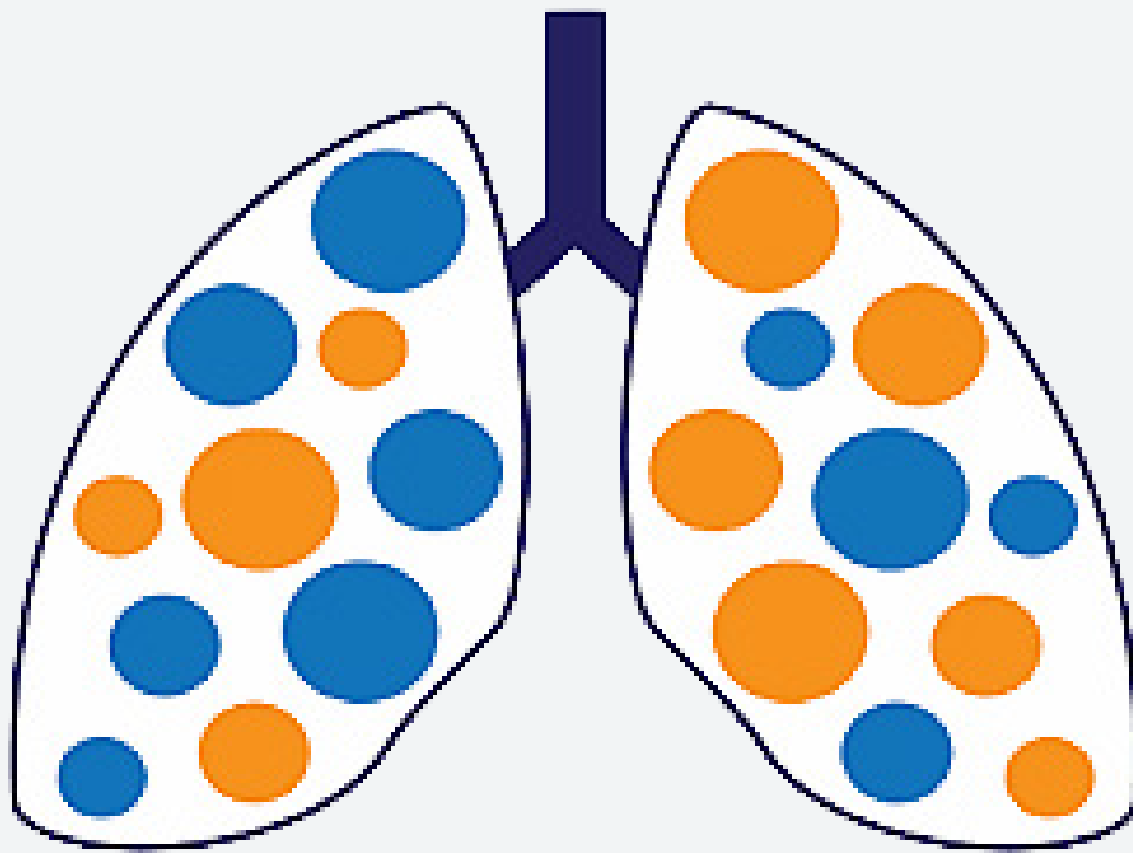

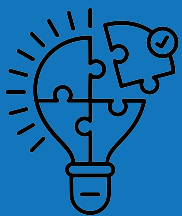
What is ARDS?

ARDS (Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome) is a serious lung condition that makes it very hard to breathe. This happens when the lungs fill with too much fluid.



Why is this study important?

There are two main types of ARDS — called hyperinflammatory and hypoinflammatory. They act a bit differently, and people with each type might need different treatments.



What is PANTHER trying to do?

The PANTHER study is working to find out which treatments work best for each type of ARDS. By doing this, doctors hope to help patients recover faster and breathe easier.



Who can take part?

If you, a friend, or a family member are in hospital with ARDS or a similar breathing problem, doctors may talk to you about joining the study.
